Nursing Excellence Endowed Fund

The Dixie Webb Nursing Excellence Endowed Fund was established in Fall 2023 by Katie and Greg Keeley of Lawrenceburg Bourbon Company. The fund was established in honor of Dixie Webb, an incredible nurse educator who served as teacher, mentor, friend, and caregiver to countless students, colleagues, and patients throughout her career. The first award(s) will be granted in Fall 2024, and the endowed fund will exist in perpetuity, supporting future nurses for many generations to come.

Funds shall be used to support students in the Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) Program at the BCTC Lawrenceburg Campus who are facing financial hardship. Preference will be given to students who are primary caregivers in their family, and students must be on track to complete at least one semester of coursework in the ADN program during the semester in which they apply for the award. When evaluating financial need, any costs that may impact a student's participation and success in the Nursing program shall be considered, including (but not limited to) housing costs, childcare, transportation, caregiving expenses, food insecurity, and required books/supplies. Nursing Faculty from the BCTC Lawrenceburg Campus will play a key role in the recipient selection process.

Recipients of the award will receive the narrative included on the front page.

Katie and Greg Keeley of Lawrenceburg Bourbon Company established the Dixie Webb Nursing Excellence Endowed fund with an initial gift of \$10,000, with plans to make future contributions to the fund using proceeds from a specialty barrel of "Dixie Bourbon" that will be bottled and released annually. There is a plan to grow the fund to \$100,000 over the next few years.

Others who feel similarly inspired by Dixie and her legacy are encouraged to contribute to the fund.
